### **Advances in science and technology**

- Advances in science and technology became especially intense during the Cold War era. In the race for space, the Soviets launched Sputnik in 1957. This was followed by the start of the United States space program and an increase interest in science and math education . The United States put the first man on the moon in 1969. Following these two milestones in space exploration, the United States and the Soviet Union both launched shuttle missions to accomplish various technological and scientific tasks. The International Space Station (ISS) was a joint venture launched in 1998 by 16 nations to create a working laboratory for experimentation in space.
