For this assignment, you are to read about the first-hand account of Edward Francis' experiences in World War 1. He describes his excitement, fears, and the horrors that he and his friends experience in battle. After reading his account, you are to compose a letter to Edward, pretending to be either his mother or father. You are to comment on his experiences, address his concerns, and offer advice or comfort for getting through the remaining days of the war. Your letter should be 2-3 paragraphs in length.
