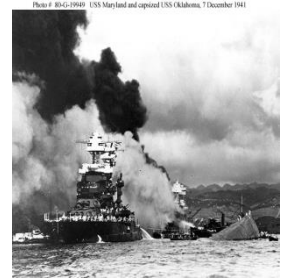

### Pearl Harbor

- \* U.S. \_\_\_\_\_ stationed at Pearl Harbor.

- \* U.S. had sent all of its aircraft carriers and most of its planes to sea.

### Hitler vs. Stalin
